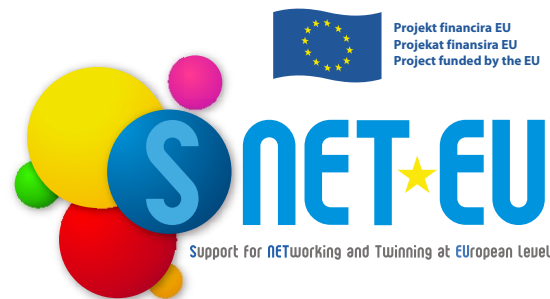

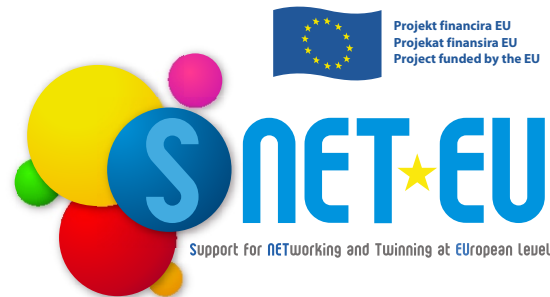

What makes the city/municipality well-known?

Vukovar is well-known as the largest port city on the Danube in Croatia, famous for its culture, history and tradition. Its city center consists of baroque buildings including Eltz Manor and Workers' Hall. Vukovar is also known for the remains of Vučedol culture, one of the oldest in Europe. The recent history of Vukovar was marked by the Croatian War of Independence in 1991, which took thousands of lives and caused great material damage to the city. Today, there are monuments that are reminders of that - the Water Tower, the Cross at the confluence of the Vuka river and the Danube, and many others. Daily, Vukovar undergoes major regeneration, both material and social.
