

Internship in the area of Corporate and private fundraising Office in Vicenza

Duration of the Internship: To be agreed - Preferably 6 months **Location**: The Corporate and Private Fundraising Unit is based in Vicenza (Italy) –

The European Association for Local Democracy (ALDA) offers an internship in the field of Project Development. The incumbent will work under the supervision of the Corporate and Private Fundraising Unit Coordinator of ALDA, who is also the tutor responsible for the internship.

Main tasks and responsibilities:

- Research and study: Scouting of potential donors
- Elaboration of applications
- Preparation of materials: power points, texts for promotional materials
- Strategies development

The internship also includes administrative and office tasks, mainly related to the preparation and the submission – but also the implementation and the reporting – of private funding.

The tasks will be defined according to the experience of the trainee and can be changed and further "develop" during the internship.

The internship in the Corporate and private fundraising office takes place in Vicenza and normally lasts a minimum period of 6 months.

The intern will work under the supervision of the Corporate and Private Fundraising Unit Coordinator of ALDA – the European Association of Local Democracy Agencies, who is also the tutor responsible for the internship.
