

Action 4.3c — Youth Support Systems — Support to youth workers' mobility and exchanges

Deadline for expressing sending us your expression of interest: 15th of August 2010

This Action aims to support projects in the field of youth workers mobility, promoting exchanges between workers of Non-governmental organisations and/or local public bodies, both payed employees and volunteers, provided that they could demonstrate a minimum of two years of relevant professional experience in the field concerned. Under each project can be supported up to two youth workers' individual mobility, and the workers shall have a structured and stable cooperation with the sending organisation and no age limit is forecast.

The overall objectives of the proposal are: to provide youth workers with the possibility to experience a different working environment, thus making them more aware of the European dimension of Youth work and of the different approaches to youth work and non-formal education in Europe. Furthermore, the program aims at improving skills and competencies of the workers involved and at creating a stable partnership between youth organisations across Europe.

ALDA has a great experience in the field of policy youth and training and can contribute with its attested methodology to the networking between organisations.
