

## CROSS OVER

### Terms of Reference for 2 volunteers

Lead partner: AGORA CE

Hosting partner: ALDA

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

CROSS OVER is a project that focuses on fostering participation in the European Parliament elections and active engagement in the EU community life by all its citizens, by improving conditions for democratic civic commitment. The project will be targeting specifically 6 eurosceptic EU member states: Croatia, Slovenia, Hungary, Slovakia, Czech Republic and Poland where participation in 2014 European Parliament elections was low.

The 2 volunteers will help to reach these objectives by supporting the different activities of the CROSS OVER project. Based in Italy, they will support remotely the organisation and communication of the local and international events taking place in the target countries. On a monthly basis, they will travel by car to the 6 different hosting partners over the course of 5 months during which they will implement local activities in the hosting countries and will support the preparation and implementation of the international events.

The 2 volunteers will be hosted by a partner of the CROSS OVER project, ALDA, in its office in Vicenza, Italy. They will be trained and will contribute to the planning and preparation of local activities in the hosting countries as well as contribute to the communication and dissemination effort of the project. At the same time, they will experience the work of an international NGO working on active citizenship and EU values.

Activities in each hosting country will focus on a different theme linked to the EU: What is the EU? What does the EU deal with? The EU Parliament and political representation; Model European Parliament (MEP); The future of the EU and its challenges; EU elections and euroscepticism; Local authorities for greater EU political participation.
