The EaP CSF Pavel Sheremet Award was established in 2016 in order to recognise courage in journalism and outstanding achievement in the cause of media freedom in the Eastern Partnership region. For the third time it will highlight reporting on injustice and human rights abuses. While freedom of the media in the Eastern Partnership countries has been deteriorating in the past years, its importance cannot be overestimated.

This award honours an acclaimed critic of authoritarian leaders Pavel Sheremet, who was killed in a car bomb explosion in 2016, for his exceptional contribution to the promotion of human rights and freedom of speech.
