The project is a large-scale European (EU) collaborative project ideated by Nordisk Teaterlaboratorium - Odin Teatret, as lead partner and Social Community Theatre Centre Dep. Studium (Unito) as methodological supervisor. The project takes its departure from a former EU cooperation project *CARAVAN. Artists on the road*, which ended in 2014.

Caravan NEXT is a Social Community Theatre project and aims to stimulate every individual and every community to reflect on the active role of the European citizenship with regards to the social challenges awaiting us, among these, such as: gender equality, acceptance of other cultures, environmental protection, the role of young people in contemporary society.

The project will during three and a half year engage with European citizens in 21 countries in and outside Europe by social community theatre and art. In total 5 main festive weeks and 25 smaller artistic interventions will be managed the 13 partners in a participatory way with communities all over Europe.

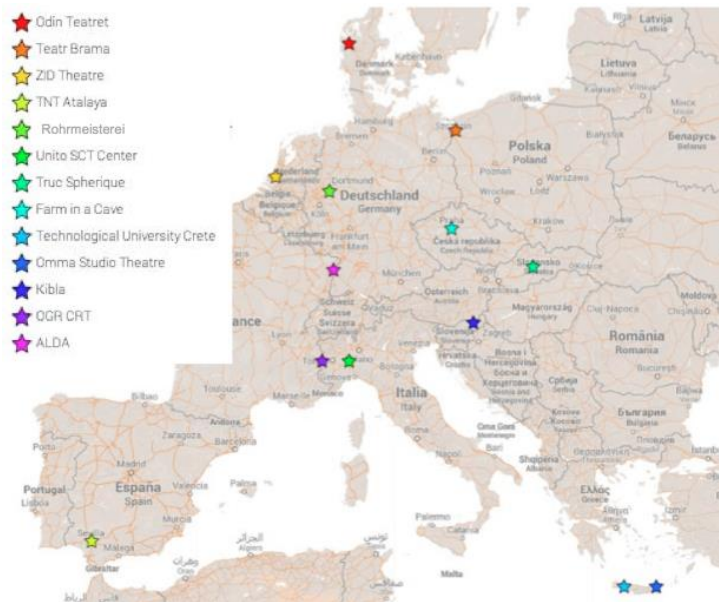
