

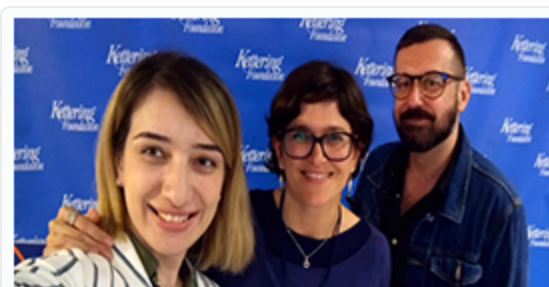

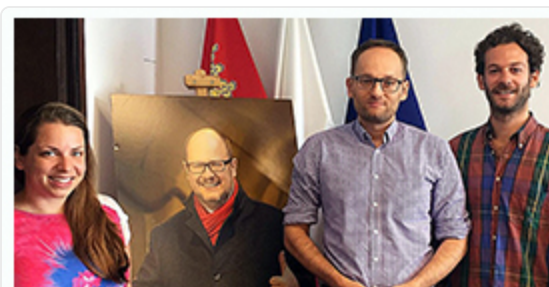

LEARNING FROM THE PAST TO ACHIEVE A BETTER EUROPE
