Capacity building for local governments and civil society, the school for local democracy, training seminars for youth groups, making documentary films, awareness raising and publishing activities is some of the main components of the action. Intercultural dialogue and understanding, respect for ethnic and cultural diversity, intercultural governance and participation at local level are the main values promoted.
