Description

This was the closing event for the SPUR project.

It provided an opportunity for the project partners to meet one last time and discuss their experiences over the past two years.

The first day began with a welcome and lunch at the Inno'vet Centre (1:00–2:00 p.m.), providing an opportunity for informal exchanges among partners. Through the discussion the consortium partners shared the results of the action plans implementation in their contexts and with the local communities target. This exchange set the basis for discussing potential follow ups of the project, a decision that met the desire of the unanimity of partners.

The morning session of the second day (9:00 a.m.–12:00 p.m.) was dedicated to presentations by the Municipality of Etterbeek on participatory financing campaigns implemented at municipal level, such as the crowlending campaign, and citizen participation initiatives, such as the institution of new Consultative Councils within the Municipality.

The event ended with a volunteer evening, which provided an opportunity to meet Etterbeek residents who volunteer in the community and have been involved within the SPUR project's activities. The volunteers' night was an informal moment where different people were invited to meet and to chat with each others in the entrance hall of the Etterbeek Town Hall, that was set up as a city square.

The participants were mostly citizens from the Municipality: young people, elders and people with migratory background were the most represented target groups. During the night, the Mayor took the floor to address a speech to the participants.
