BACKGROUND

The Gender, Inclusion, and Human Rights Hub focuses on these three topics with an Intersectional Approach, as social identities work on multiple levels, resulting in unique experiences, opportunities and barriers for each person. In fact, an intersectional approach shows that people's social identities can overlap, creating compounding experiences of discrimination.

Gender equality remains an essential yet unfulfilled goal globally. While strides have been made, disparities persist, particularly in caregiving roles. Traditional gender norms often place the burden of caregiving disproportionately on women, hindering their opportunities for education, employment, and advancement. To address these challenges, ALDA is organizing a workshop on gender equality and caregiving, aiming to foster discussions, share insights, and propose actionable solutions to promote gender equality in caregiving roles.

PRESENTATION OF THE EVENT

The workshop will be structured as a roundtable discussion featuring diverse perspectives from experts, practitioners, and advocates in the field of gender equality and caregiving. The format will include a panel discussion – possible interactive activity at the end.
