Thematic Focus



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This call seeks to support impactful initiatives that are aimed at fostering **European Citizenship** by improving conditions for civic and democratic participation in Europe. Specifically, the thematic focus of the actions should be on strengthening civic participation in the EU, and align with **ALDA Thematic Hubs**.

Civic Participation in the EU

Proposals should **strengthen citizens' engagement and participation in democratic life** while empowering individuals and organizations to understand, advocate for, and actively contribute to the respect of EU rights and values at the local level.

Values of **non-discrimination** and **equality** (including gender equality), and the promotion of **inclusivity** must be integrated in all foreseen actions, regardless of their specific objectives. In fact, proposals should clearly articulate how these values will be integrated into the project design, implementation, and outcomes.

Eligibility



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- **Be a legal entity, non profit organisation**
- **Be established in a Member State of the EU;**
- **Respect EU values as laid down in Art. 2 of the Treaty on European Union and the EU Charter of fundamental rights;**
- **Be directly responsible for the preparation and management of the action, not acting as an intermediary;**
- **Be a member of ALDA**
- **Commit to ALDA's "Gender Equality and anti discrimination policy" and to sign the statements for members, if they have yet to do so.**

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A new structure for the budget

The form is a *mixed-budget based*, the reimbursement is on the basis of actual eligible costs plus a percentage for the personnel costs.

To be **eligible**, the costs:

- are incurred during the **lifetime of the submitted proposal** and partnership agreement
- are **indicated** in the estimated overall budget of the submitted proposal
- are **necessary** for the implementation of the project
- are **identifiable and verifiable**, in particular being recorded in the accounting records
- comply with the requirements of **applicable tax and social legislation.**
- are **real costs, reasonable, justified**
- they are **not covered through EU grants** in the form of contribution to unit costs, lump sums or flat-rate financing.

Grant

For the Personnel costs as flat rate contribution:

The costs for flat-rate contribution that will be considered as “eligible costs” are all costs incurred by the beneficiary which meet all of the following criteria:

- They must be declared under the budget line Personnel costs as planned in the application phase
- They must **not cover other kind of costs** apart than Personnel costs
- They must **fulfil the general eligibility conditions** for the type of cost concerned
- The usual accounting practices must be applied in a consistent manner, based on objective criteria, regardless of the source of funding.

Grant



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For the budget planning and reporting:

Out of the total grant, the staff costs budget line can be considered up to a maximum of 30% of the grant. Applicants can also decide to lower the percentage from 30% to 20% or 10%, or - in case they consider to have no need for the staff costs - to 0% and use the whole grant as a budget based on actual costs incurred.

The personnel costs will then be reported as percentage on the total budget, no supporting documents for the staff costs will be asked at this phase but they need to be kept and available in case of audits by the EC.

All the other actual costs will be supported by the required documentations (i.e., contracts, invoices, proof of payments).
