Mapping local actors as a foundational step - 44 organizations

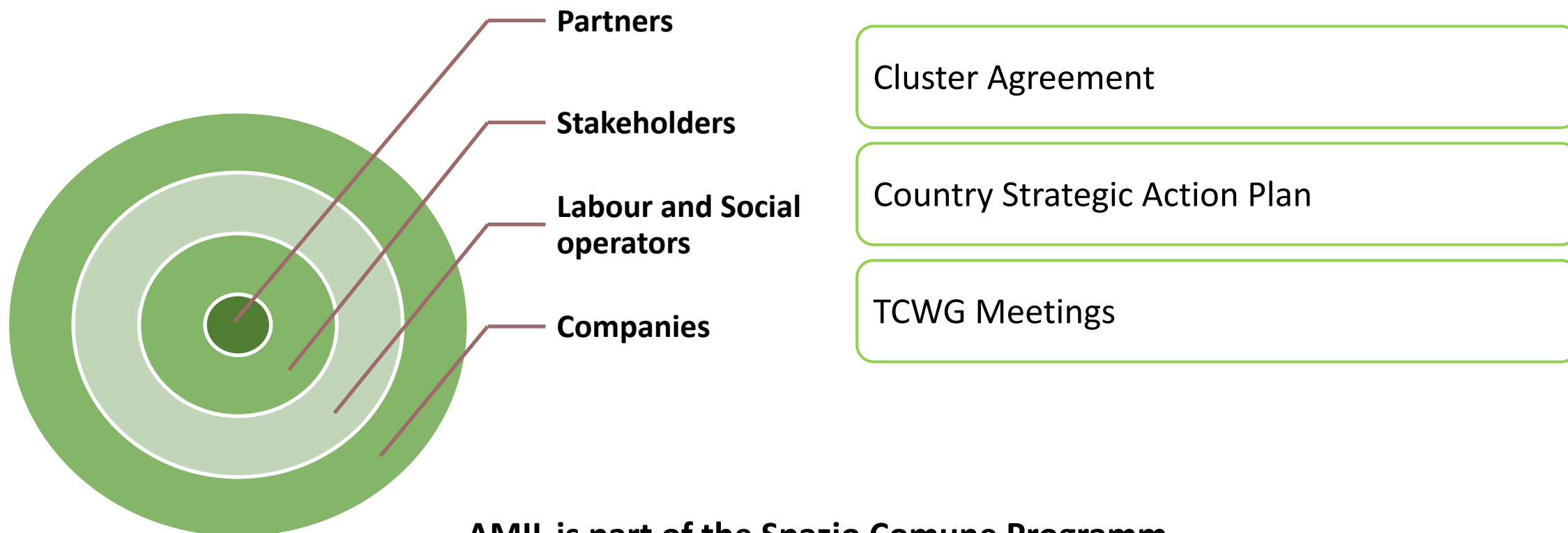
Capacity building on MEIC methodology - 45 participants, 15 organizations

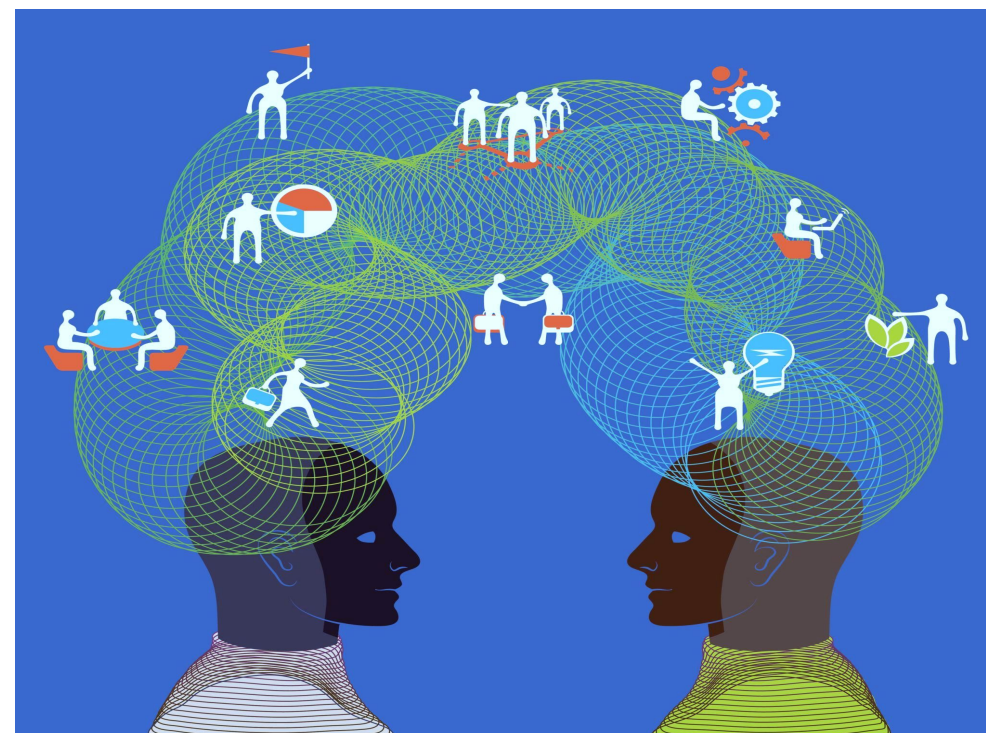
Cluster Structure and Interaction
